Richard's Endeavour is once more available for Day Cruises for the new season after a full repaint and improvements to facilities, in particular for wider wheelchairs.

With a trained volunteer crew on board, the boat is available for wonderful day cruises along the Leeds Liverpool Canal from Skipton.

We can accommodate a maximum of 12 passengers. This can include up to four wheelchairs subject to certain requirements.

ACCESSIBLE BOAT

Endeavour has a cabin which can be accessed via a wheelchair lift. An accessible disability toilet and an open plan kitchenette area are also available.



ACCESSIBLE CANAL

Our charity is all about helping people get onto the canal. Our customers, who are often housebound or have various disabilities, love their days out on the canal with our lovely crews.



ACCESSIBLE PRICE

We are a charity, run entirely by volunteers, so we can keep a day's cruising to a very accessible £225 for the day for a maximum of 12 passengers.

EXPERIENCE THE TRANQUILITY OF THE CANAL

◆ YOUR DAY

Arriving at the boarding point in central Skipton in readiness for 10.30am departure, you will be met by the Skipper and crew and welcomed on board. Once everyone is settled, the day begins with a brief introduction and safety advice by the Skipper, and then you're off!

Endeavour can go either north to the open countryside between Skipton and Gargrave, or south to Kildwick and through the fabulous bluebell strewn woods - with a possible sighting of deer. Either way, you will see the local swans, hopefully a heron or two and be able to take in the scenery as the boat glides through the water.

The boat comes equipped with tea and coffee, but groups need to organise their own lunch. We are able to stop in the Skipton Canal Basin for you to collect a fish and chips lunch from the famous Bizzy Lizzies. There are some cooking facilities on board as an alternative, or you can bring a buffet lunch with you.

We arrive back at the starting point between 3.00 and 3.30pm for you and your group to be collected after a wonderful day out.

OUR CREW

Our volunteer skippers all hold a qualification recognised by the Maritime and Coastguard Agency. Our volunteer crew are all trained and some have been with the boat for many years.



WHEELCHAIRS

We can fit up to a maximum of four wheelchairs on board - The access door to the lift has been widened so we are now able to accommodate the majority of larger wheelchairs.



BOOKING

The boat now operates Monday to Saturday. To book one of these days, head on over to our website and find a free date. Send us a booking request and we will contact you to take payment and confirm the booking.

Sunday trips can sometimes be arranged. Please check with us to see if we can arrange a crew.
